The use of technology and how teacher can use — This enables a person to direct the attention to a specific part of the visual that is being emphasized and may also be constructed in several parts. The teacher must carefully plan and design the transparency, so it can help the teacher make a more effective presentation. The characters of a suitable size should be 1/4 inch.
